Rio de Janeiro, 8 December 1815

"I had a long private conversation with the Prince a fortnight ago at his country house in which he spoke to me much more than is usual of the state and prospects of Europe and of our late (?) war with England and its successes, which he professes to think of with admiration and pleasure - The whole of his conversation respecting the United States, their commerce and future intercourse with Brazil, & my residence here was uncommonly frank, friendly and even complimentary - The tendency of it seemed to be calculated ~~to be~~ purposely to ~~be~~ impress me with a belief that it was neither his policy or desire to leave Brazil, or to restore the colonial system in it, he seemed determined to make me infer that the interest I had taken in this matter ~~was not~~ ~~which~~ when Admiral Bessford was here was by no means displeasing to him and that he was determined to consider the manifestation I had on it (?) of that interest as directed by my government or inspired by some certain knowledge of its policy ~~and~~ ~~in what~~ ~~and~~ ~~with~~ ~~which~~ In short I could not help take to believe that it was
